## Professor Emeritus of Psychology Olaf Millert is committed to supporting St. Olaf students.

**H**elping students is an important part of Olaf Millert's life. The Estonian immigrant, who founded the St. Olaf Psychology Department in 1960, says he's just repaying the kindness that others have shown him throughout his life.

St. Olaf learned recently that Millert is planning to leave his estate to the college. This gift, along with a history of establishing various endowments for the college, has prompted St. Olaf to name a laboratory space in Regents Hall in honor of Millert and his late wife, Jutta Rae Millert '65.

The Millerts first established the Gordon Allport award, given annually to a junior psychology major and named in honor of Olaf Millert's mentor. This was followed by the Olaf and Jutta Millert Endowment which provides funds for students from Baltic and Scandinavian countries, and the Jutta R. Millert Memorial Speaker Series in Psychology.

"This has been our attempt to help, financially and otherwise, young people of different backgrounds. And why shouldn't I give to the only college that happens to carry my name?" he says.
